### What is Flexiteek made of ?

Flexiteek is PVC composite, made up of about 55% PVC and other materials that create the finished panel.

### How long has Flexiteek been around?

Flexiteek has been sold for ten years in Europe and five years in the US.

### How do you take care of Flexiteek ?

Flexiteek is easy to maintain: just keep clean with soap and boat brush as you would any other deck. (Joy dish soap or Simple Green works well)

Flexiteek can be sanded just like wood if cleaning is neglected or surface becomes scratched.

Fish blood, oil and red wine washes away without staining deck. If neglected, a surface stain can be easily removed by lightly sanding using 60-grit sandpaper.

There is no need to sand the entire deck, sanded areas will blend in with the rest of the panel within a couple days.

Flexiteek never needs oiling or sealing.

### Where is Flexiteek made ?

Flexiteek is produced in Sweden and the panels are built in Texas.

### Is Flexiteek a veneer ?

No, Flexiteek is a solid color throughout its thickness.

The caulk lines are extruded in the panel so they can never come out. Flexiteek is the only marine deck system that you can use a pressure washer on without removing caulk lines during the cleaning.

Unlike other panel systems, Flexiteek panels are welded together rather than glued creating a water proof deck panel that can help protect your boat from water damage.

### Does Flexiteek fade or go gray like wood decks ?

No, Flexiteek is UV stable and will not fade or change color in time, if anything it may become slightly darker over time.

### How is Flexiteek installed?

Flexiteek is installed with a one-part marine waterproof adhesive (Bostik Adhesive 940A) just like installing household flooring.

A 1/8" notched trowel is used to spread the glue over the entire deck area. You can walk on the new deck within 12 hours.

### How do I buy Flexiteek ?

Flexiteek can be purchased directly from SeaJay Marine Group

To get a price quote, draw on a piece of paper the outline of the areas you wish to cover with Flexiteek and show all dimensions, then fax to SeaJay Marine Group at (321) 238-6316. We will respond with a price quote within 24 hours.

**Does cold weather affect Flexiteek ?**

When Flexiteek is glued in position, the panels are not affected by cold weather. Flexiteek was developed in Scandinavia where there are very extreme temperatures.

Flexiteek has excellent non-slip properties, the wetter it gets the better it grips.

**How much does Flexiteek cost?**

Prices range from \$45 to \$65 per square foot depending on the job.

Shipping (if necessary) is extra.

A more precise price quote can be given by faxing us a diagram of the area with measurements.

**Other information**

Flexiteek is sold to nearly 20 boat manufacturers directly.

Flexiteek does not come in different shades/colors, only black or white caulk lines.

Flexiteek is available in 45mm (1 3/4") and 60mm (2 3/8") wide caulk line spacing.
